Join ACE for a special event in Hudson this Wednesday, July 22nd, for two private 10-person tours of the Rodney Alan Greenblat show, "<u>Something to Look Forward to</u>" hosted by the artist himself! One tour will begin 4pm and the other will begin at 4:45pm. Each tour lasts 45 minutes.

Rodney Alan Greenblat is a visionary artist, designer, and writer who has been making whimsical colorful artwork for over thirty years. In addition to his contribution to the downtown New York art scene, he has designed album covers, video game characters and fantastical worlds. One of Greenblat's most notable contributions to pop culture was the 1990s Sony Playstation game **PaRappa the Rapper**. Greenblat's new and archival works are on display in this completely wonderful, delightfully uplifting show.

Resource for Employers: Shared Work Program



The Shared Work Program gives businesses and nonprofits an alternative to laying off workers during business downturns by allowing them to work a reduced work schedule and collect partial Unemployment Insurance benefits for up to 26 weeks.

Information on the Shared Work Program can be found on the <u>Department of Labor</u> website.
